

How to live the life of Fullness that God has for me.

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To live to the fullest is to enjoy the whole inheritance, the whole package of what Jesus has won for me.

I cannot live in all the fullness to which God has called me if I do not know what is my inheritance in Him.

Paul's Prayer reflects God's desire for us:

Ephesians 1:17-23

Knowing God BETTER

The Father has revealed himself to us. He has taken the initiative to allow us to know Him. Because of Christ we have access to His riches in glory. Because of the Holy Spirit I can have a spirit of wisdom and revelation so that I can understand:

- Who God is
- Who I am in Him
- What I have access to
- What great things God wants you to do that will bring Him glory.

3 revelations that arise from knowing God better.

God can enlighten the eyes of my heart to:

To know the HOPE to which I am called.

Ephesians 1:3, 10, 18 I have an eternal hope, that I may become holy and blameless before God, that I may be gathered to him, that I may be a praise to him of his glory.

Know the richness of my INHERITANCE

Ephesians 1:5 and Ephesians 1:11 Because God has adopted me as his child, I can access every spiritual blessing in Christ. My inheritance in Christ is rich and abundant, including, among other things, forgiveness of sins, his grace, wisdom, and understanding.

Know the POWER at my fingertips:

Ephesians 1:19 The power of God at my disposal is exceedingly great and efficient, and is available for those who believe in Christ, and it is the same power that God exercised to raise Jesus from the dead. The Holy Spirit in me brings this wonderful power with which I can carry out the work God entrusts to me and honor Him.

Barometer to know how well I know God:

What are my prayers like?

The content of my prayers says a lot about me, what I believe about God, and what I know about Him.

5 types of Prayers:

1. The absent ones
2. The little ones
3. The selfish ones
4. The safe ones
5. The brave ones

Knowing God better will lead us to raise more courageous prayers.

Ephesians 3:14-21

The better I know God and what my inheritance is in Christ, the fuller my life will be and greater glory I will be able to give him.

2. Inside the Bible

Let's read Paul's two prayers for the Church of Ephesus:

Read Ephesians 1:15-19 and Read Ephesians 3:14-21

What stands out to you most about these two sentences?

How big and courageous do you think Paul's prayer is for the Church of Ephesus?

Why do you think Paul thought it was very important for them to know God better?

Do you find the Trinity in these prayers?

In one sentence, what is Paul's request for the Church?

3. Application.

The theme of this meeting is titled " How to live the life of Fullness that God has for me."

- Discuss as a group some spiritual disciplines and practices that we may have that help us to grow in the knowledge of God.

Comment: What has knowing God better done for you?

End by praying for one another by paraphrasing Paul's prayer in Ephesians 1:17-19

Family Altar: Let's talk about these questions: Are we walking in victory and fullness? Do our actions bring glory to God? Does our prayer life reflect that we know God and what we have access to thanks to Christ? Plan to get to know God better as a family and have Him be known by someone you love who does not yet know Him.
