

# KNOWING HIM AND MAKING HIM KNOWN

*To those who love me, I reciprocate; to those who seek me, I make myself known.*

*Proverbs 8:17*

## 1. God wants to make himself known:

To whom is He made known? To those who seek Him.

A requirement for knowing God is to seek Him through the reading of His Word.

*Jeremiah 29:13*

*They will seek Me and find Me when they seek Me with all their hearts.*

Do you want to know more about God?

You have to look for him wholeheartedly.

## 2. By seeking and trusting in God we find:

God brings blessing when we seek Him and trust Him.

*Jeremiah 17:8*

Blessed is the man who trusts in the Lord and puts his trust in Him.

### A. Security

*Psalms 18:2*

*Thou art to me the rock that gives me refuge; thou hast cared for me and delivered me. You protect me like a shield and save me with your power. You are my highest hiding place!*

*Romans 15:13-14*

*May God, who gives us security, fill you with joy. May He give them the peace that comes from trusting Him. And may he fill you with hope by the power of the Holy Spirit.*

Example: *Exodus 14* (Red Sea Crossing).

### B. Peace

Lack of peace brings fear and anguish into our lives.

*Isaiah 41:10*

*So do not be afraid because I am with you, do not be distressed because I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you with the right hand of my righteousness.*

Example: *Matthew 8:23-27*.

God takes away the fear and anguish in my life.

What is it that takes away my peace and generates fear or anguish? What storm are you going through (Illness, economic situation, family problems, etc.)?

Remember that Jesus is with you and wants to give you peace in that situation.

*Isaiah 26:3*

*Thou shalt keep in perfect peace all that trust in thee, all that concentrate their thoughts upon thee.*

### C. Guidance

*Isaiah 48:17*

*Thus says the Lord your Redeemer, the Holy One of Israel: I am the Lord your God, who teaches you what is good for you, who guides you in the way you should walk.*

*Psalms 25:4-5*

*Show me the right path, O Lord; show me the way I should go. Guide me with your truth and teach me, for you are the God who saves me. All day long I put my hope in you.*

Example: *Joshua 6* (Guidance to attack the city of Jericho).

*Galatians 5:16*

*Therefore, I say to you, let the Holy Spirit guide you in life.*

### D. Salvation

*1 John 1:5-7*

*This is the message that we have heard from him and that we proclaim: God is light and in him there is no darkness. But if we live in the light, just as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another and the blood of his Son Jesus Christ cleanses us from all sin*

*Ephesians 2:5,8*

*So, even though we were dead in sins, he gave us life by raising Christ up. We have been saved thanks to God's love. You have been saved because you accepted God's love. None of you earned salvation, but God gave it to you.*

## 3. Share what we have found:

### Sharing our testimony:

By sharing the Good News of Salvation through our life and testimony and word.

*1 Thessalonians 2:8*

*We love them so much that we not only present to them the Good News of God, but we also open our own lives to them.*

### Sharing the Good News of Salvation:

*Romans 1:17*

*The good news teaches us that God accepts those who believe in Jesus. As the Bible says: Those whom God has accepted, and trust in him, will live forever.*

## 3. Taking Action:

What has God spoken to you through this talk? How could you put it into practice in your life?

What actions do you think you need to take to fully seek and trust God?

What actions could you take to share more of what Jesus has done in you, to other people?

What actions could you take to improve your life of obedience to God?
