Questions and Passages for Further Study

1. Getting to know each other:

Discuss as a group: How did you hear about Jesus?

2. Inside the Bible:

This Sunday we looked at a process that involves "Setting Our Eyes on Jesus":

Hearing—Believing—Seeking—Abiding—Witnessing—Leading Others to Jesus.

Let's read the following passage where we can see the ministry of Jesus: *Matthew 9:35-38*, this passage is a good description of the task of the Church:

- **He went through all the cities and villages in that region:** God has given us a circle of influence that we need to reach.

What is the circle of influence that God has called you to reach?

- **Announcing the Good News about the Kingdom:** We have a message of good news, the gospel, and sound doctrine.

How are you preparing to know and handle this Kingdom message well?

- **It healed all disease and disease:** (Disease refers beyond physical situations, emotional, relational and soul areas)

What ailments has Jesus healed you of? (make a list among all)

Are there ailments that God cannot heal?

- **He had Compassion:** This is our motivation... compassion, love, and mercy.

How can we grow in compassion for the lost and needy?

- **Confused and helpless** - sheep without a Shepherd.

What is the strategy we use to give this shepherding at Iglesia PAZ?

What confusions did you have before that you can now say that Christ has taken away from you?

Do you believe that Christ through His Church can provide the shelter needed by someone who feels helpless? How can you be a part of that?

3. Application for Life:

The harvest is great- The few workers:

Why is it that there is more need than workers to attend to it?

What happens in your heart when you see the great need around us?

Pray to the Lord of the harvest... Ask for workers:

If we want more workers, what is the strategy we should follow? What does Jesus tell us to do?

What will these workers God send be like?

Read *1 Timothy 3:8-13*

Are you one of these workers?

How are you preparing to testify of Christ?

For the Family Altar: Read *Romans 10:17* together and discuss: Are each of the members of the family growing in faith? According to this verse, what can help us grow our faith?

Is there anyone we need to talk to about Jesus? End up praying for that person.
